Many flowering plants bloom and have wonderful scents. In the past, people who lived in the village used to meet in the fields and gardens where they prepared for planting and sowing.

Morena (a straw effigy) symbolised the winter and so when people wanted the spring to come, they had to drown her in a stream or burn her. The date of burning of Morena is the Dead Sunday – 2 weeks before Easter. Nowadays, the tradition is popular only in the villages.
